

Email records create a traceable history of reported cases which can be valuable for investigations. The college's support system for ragging and sexual harassment including the suggestion box, mentorship programme and email channels are crucial in ensuring a safe and supportive environment for all students.

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

Minutes of Meetings of Students Grievances Redressal Committee

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

